The work methods of Imre Lukács, the hog breeder of the “Táncsics” cooperative farm in Makó.

In each year since 1949, Imre Lukács, hog breeder of the “Táncsics” cooperative farm in Makó, has made the 20 sows of the farm reproduce twice a year. He has raised 1,113 pigs from 20 sows over the course of three years.

The biggest help in raising and caring for the swine is his wife, who is also a member of the cooperative farm.

Imre Lukács and his wife fulfilled 700 units of work. Their compensation was 10 thousand Forints in cash, 16 quintals of wheat, 33 quintals of corn, 280 kilos of sugar and other benefits in kind.

They were given this pig as an award for exceeding the goals of the breeding plan.

Imre Lukács takes part in continued education. In his absence his aids and wife stand in for him. They all know that knowledge is power.

By following the pig raising methods of the “Táncsics” cooperative farm’s pig breeder, we can help realize the pig breeding goals set forth by the Five Year Plan, as well as obtain higher wages.
